



Note from the Director

STEFFAN DONNELLY



Croeso! Diolch yn fawr am ddod i Parti Priodas.

Ry'n ni'n gobeithio y gwnewch chi fwynhau'r ddrama newydd yma sy'n ddireidus, teimladwy ac yn rhoi her gyffrous i ddu actor wrth iddynt chwarae degau o gymeriadau yr un!

Cafodd y ddrama ei gyflwyno yn gyntaf yn Eisteddfod Genedlaethol Llŷn ac Eifionydd y llynedd lle roedd ciwiau i'w gweld o un ben y Maes i'r llall. Roedd hynny'n arwydd clir bod angen i ni fynd â hon ar daith!

Mae teithio mor agos at stepen ddrws pobl Cymru yn ganolog i'n gweledigaeth ac mae'r sioe yn ymweld â dipyn o leoliadau newydd i Theatr Gen – o Glwb Rygbi Nant Conwy i Wyl Gomedi Machynlleth. Rwy'n edrych ymlaen at weld cynulleidfa oedd yn ymateb i'r wledd o gomedi ffaeth a phwerus – a pherfformiadau arbennig Mared Llywelyn a Mark Henry Davies.

Croeso! Thank you so much for coming to Parti Priodas.

We hope you enjoy this new play which is both mischievous and poignant and which offers the two actors an exciting challenge as they each play multiple characters!

The play was first staged at last year's Llŷn and Eifionydd National Eisteddfod where we saw queues form from one end of the Maes to the other. That was a clear indication that we just had to take this on tour!

Visiting places close to the doorsteps of people in Wales is central to our vision and the show visits quite a few new venues for Theatr Gen – from Nant Conwy Rugby Club to the Machynlleth Comedy Festival. I'm looking forward to seeing the audiences' response to the feast of witty and powerful comedy – and the fantastic performances of Mared Llywelyn and Mark Henry Davies.

Mae dawn Gruffudd i sgwennu comedï ac arsylwi ar yr absprd yn y dydd i ddydd yn wych – mae'n dod â dagrau (doniol ac emosiyonl) i lygaid rywun. Mae'n creu byd gafaelgar sy'n cynnwys sefyllfaeodd y gallwn uniaethu â nhw, yn llawn cymeriadau cymhleth, ac yn ein twyws drwy stori aml-haenog. Ymmsg y doniolwch mae haenau rhamantus, ieithyddol, amaethyddol a gwleidyddol – gan gynnwys archwilio i'r sefyllfa bresennol yng nghefn gwlad Cymru, cwestiynau am ddyfodol ein hiaith, a phroblemau unigedd.

Mae datblygu sgwennu newydd yn ran allweddol o waith Theatr Gen ac rydw i'n falch o gyflwyno drama ddoniol a pherthnasol sy'n herio – sy'n gallu bod yn ddadleuol – ac sydd yn sbarduno cwestiynau mawr am Gymru heddiw. Rydw i'n credu bod gan *Parti Priodas* y cynhwysion i fod yn glasur fodern.

Ar ôl cyflwyno *Rhinoseros* (clasur absprd Ewropeaidd), *Swyn* (sioe blant mewn iaith Arwyddo Prydeinig a Chymraeg), *le le le* (sioe wedi ei chyd-greu efo pobl ifanc am gydysynio) a'r *Kiki Cymraeg* (perfformiad sgratsh o noswaith cwïar efo Cymuned Ddawnsfa Cymru) yn ddiweddar, dyma ddrâma holol wahanol eto. Dwi'n gobeithio bod ystod eang gwaith Theatr Gen yn cynnig profiadau theatrig difyr sy'n siarad i gymunedau amrywiol Cymru.

Yndydyn ni wedi bod drwy lot dros y blynnyddoedd dwytha? Dwi'n gobeithio bod awr yng nghwmni Lowri ac Idris yn gwneud i chi chwerthin a dathlu gwytnwch Cymreictod – dewch i ddawnsio!

Gruffudd's talent for writing comedy and his observation on the absurd in day-to-day life is wonderful – it brings tears (of laughter and emotion) to one's eyes. It creates a captivating world containing situations we can relate to, full of complex characters, and takes us through a multi-layered story. Running through the comedy are romantic, linguistic, agricultural and political layers – including an exploration of the current situation in rural Wales, questions about the future of our language, and the problems of isolation.

Developing new writing is a key part of Theatr Gen's work and I'm proud to present a funny and relevant play that challenges – that can be controversial – and that poses the big questions about Wales today. I think *Parti Priodas* has all the ingredients of a modern classic.

Having recently staged *Rhinoseros* (a European absurdist classic), *Swyn* (a children's show in Welsh and British Sign Language), *le le le* (a show co-created with young people about consent) and *Kiki Cymraeg* (a scratch performance of a queer night with the Welsh Ballroom Community), this is a completely different play again. I hope Theatr Gen's wide range of work provides engaging theatrical experiences that speak to the diverse communities in Wales.

Haven't we been through a lot over the past few years? I hope an hour with Lowri and Idris makes you laugh and celebrate the resilience of being Welsh – let's dance!

*Mae priodasau'n bethau
rhyfedd...*

"Lowri: *Maen nhw'n lyfli...*

Idris: *..ond maen nhw'n boring.*

Lowri: *Ac mae 'na jans bod chdi
am neud twat o chdi dy hun..."*

A pha syndod?! Mae priodasau'n gorfodi
pobol anghymharus i dreulio lot o amser
efo'i gilydd heb lawer i'w wneud ond yfed
a dawsio... wrth gwrs bod tuedd i bethau
droi yn flêr!

Mae hon hefyd yn briodas gymsg rhwng
mab ffarm o Gymro a Saesnes o Llyn. Felly
mae'r tensiynau ieithyddol a demograffig
sydd wastad yn llechu dan yr wyneb yn
Llŷn yno i'w gweld yn blaen. Achos, fel
dywed Lowri...

"Lowri: *Mae 'na lot mwy ohonyn
nhw na sy' na ohonan ni..."*

Weddings are weird...

"Lowri: *They're lovely...*

Idris: *...but they're boring.*

Lowri: *And there's a good chance
that you're going to make a twat
of yourself..."*

It's hardly a surprise! Weddings force a
bunch of incompatible people to spend a
whole day together with little to do besides
drink and dance to cheesy music...of
course things tend to get a little messy!

This particular wedding is a mixed
marriage between a Welsh speaking
farmer's son and the daughter of English-
speaking incomers. So, the linguistic and
demographic tensions that always play just
under the surface in Llŷn are here plain for
all to see. Because, as Lowri says...

"Lowri: *There are so much more
of them than there are of us..."*

I rai hefyd, gall priodasau fod yn achlysuron digon unig, ac mae honno'n un o themâu mawr y ddrama. Cawn unigedd merch ffarm sy'n ceisio cynnal ffordd o fyw sy'n prysur lithro drwy'i gafael, ac unigedd hogyn sydd wedi gadael adra ond sy'n hiraethu am fro a chyfeillgarwch sydd wedi symud ymlaen hebddo.

"Idris: Dwi'n dal i feddwl am fan hyn fel adra ond tydi adra ddim yn fy nghofio i..."

Mae hi hefyd yn ddrama am neud ffâl o'ch hun yn gyhoeddus (a 'da ni gyd 'di gneud hynny rhwbyrd... siawns?!') ac am ein hangen ni fel pobol am garedigrwydd a chysylltiad, ac am deimlo ein bod ni'n perthyn i rywbeth.

Cafodd **Parti Priodas** ei pherfformio am y tro cyntaf yng Nghaffi Maes B yn Eisteddfod Genedlaethol Llŷn ac Eifionydd yn 2023. Ond mae gwreiddiau'r ddrama yn mynd yn ôl i 2018 pan ges i le ar gynllun awduron newydd Theatr Genedlaethol Cymru. Mewn cyfres o weithdai yng nghwmni cyd-awduron a mentoriaid gwych mi dyfodd egin syniad am 'briodas gymysg' yn ddrafft cynnar o *Parti Priodas*. Rydw i mor ddiolchgar i'r cwmni am eu hymroddiad i ddatblygu sgwennu newydd ac yn arbennig i Steffan Donnelly am gyfarwyddo'r ddrama ac am benderfynu mynd â hi ar daith. Dwi hefyd yn ddiolchgar iawn i wychder cynhenid Mared a Mark am roi anadl einioes i'r holl gymeriadau brith! Dwi'n eithriadol o ddyledus i'r holl dîm am eu cefnogaeth a'u hanogaeth ar hyd y daith. Diolch i chi. Mae hi 'di bod yn bleser go iawn.

Weddings can also be lonely occasions, and that is one of the play's key themes. We see the loneliness of a farmer's daughter trying to maintain a way of life that's already slipping from her grasp and the loneliness of a man who's left home, but who still yearns for a friendship and a world that has long since outgrown him.

"Idris: I still think of this place as 'home'. But 'home' doesn't remember me..."

This is also a play about making a spectacle of yourself in public (and we've all done that at some point... surely!?) and our need as a people for kindness and connection, and to feel as if we belong somewhere.

Parti Priodas was first performed in Caffi Maes B in the Llŷn and Eifionydd National Eisteddfod in 2023. But the play's inception goes back to 2018 when I won a place on Theatr Genedlaethol's new writers programme. It was on that programme, following a series of workshops in the company of talented mentors and fellow writers that the germ of an idea about 'a mixed marriage in Llŷn' turned into an early draft of *Parti Priodas*. I'm so grateful to the company for their commitment to developing new writing, especially to Steffan Donnelly for directing the play and for taking the production on tour. I'm also indebted to the actors, Mared and Mark, and to their innate awesomeness for bringing all the characters to life! I'm so thankful to the whole team for all their support and encouragement along the journey. It's been a real pleasure.

Dwi bellach 'di byw i ffwrdd o fro fy mebyd am gyfnod hirach nag y bûm i'n byw yno. Ond mae hoel fy magwraeth yn Llŷn yn drwch drwy'r ddrama hon. Mae'r cyfan yma. Yn deulu a ffrindiau bore oes, yn Saeson clwb hwylio, yn gymhlethdodau demograffig, yn argyfwng tai, yn seddi caled capel, yn ffynhonnau sanctaidd ac yn nosweithiau rhemp yn Nhŷ Newydd, Sarn. Dwi'n diolch am gael perthyn iddyn nhw'i gyd.

Fel mae Lowri'n ei ddweud yn y ddrama, "Weithiau, mae'n anodd bod yn Gymro." Tydi rhywun yn treulio gymaint o egni yn poeni am ddyfodol ein hiaith a'n cymunedau? Ond mae 'na bethau sy'n gneud y profiad werth o hefyd; fel jōcs gwirion am T. H. Parry Williams, dawnsio'n chwili 'Sebona Fi', Mistar Urdd, hen emynau, twmpathau dawns a'n holl draddodiadau gogoneddus (hyd yn oed y rhai cachu rwtsh!). Diolch o galon i'r Theatr Genedlaethol a holl deulu Parti Priodas am fod yn un arall o'r pethau hynny imi.

Mwynhewch y sioe!

I've now reached the point where I've spent a longer time living away from Llŷn than I ever did living there. But my sense of that place, and my experiences growing up there are littered through this play. They're all there: family members and old friends, the sailing club set, the demographic complexities, the hard chapel seats, the holy wells and the wild nights in Tŷ Newydd, Sarn. I'm grateful to belong to them all.

As Lowri says in the play "*Sometimes, it's hard being Welsh*". It's true. One spends so much time and energy worrying about the uncertain future of our language and its communities. But there are also things that make it so worth it; like silly jokes about T.H.Parry Williams, dancing to '*Sebona Fi*', Mistar Urdd, old hymns, twmpath dances and all our glorious traditions (even the bullshit ones!). Thank you to Theatr Genedlaethol and the whole *Parti Priodas* family for helping to create another one of those things that, for me, makes it so worth it.

Enjoy the show!



DRAMODYDD | PLAYWRIGHT

Ar ôl astudio am radd yn y Gymraeg ym Mhrifysgol Aberystwyth, aeth Gruffudd yn ei flaen i lunio traethawd MPhil ar ddramâu W.S. Jones (Wil Sam). Ar ôl rhai blynnyddoedd o weithio fel golygydd storï i *Pobol y Cwm*, mae Gruffudd bellach yn gweithio fel awdur a sgrifftiwr ar ei liwt ei hun. Yn 2019, perfformiwyd draftt cynnar o Parti Priodas fel rhan o Gynllun Dramodwyr Newydd Theatr Genedlaethol Cymru. Mae Gruff hefyd yn fardd, a fo oedd Prifardd Cadeiriol Eisteddfod Genedlaethol Caerdydd 2018. Mae'n awdur dwy gyfrol o gerddi, *Hel Llus yn y glaw* (2016) a *Mymryn Rhyddid* (2023).

Having graduated in Welsh at Aberystwyth University, Gruff went on to study for an MPhil on the plays of W.S. Jones (Wil Sam). After several years as a story editor for *Pobol y Cwm*, he now works as a freelance author and scriptwriter. In 2019, an early draft of Parti Priodas was performed as part of Theatr Genedlaethol Cymru's New Playwrights' Group to nurture new playwrights. Gruff is also a poet, and he was the Chaired Bard at the Cardiff National Eisteddfod 2018. He has published two volumes of poems, *Hel Llus yn y glaw* (2016) and *Mymryn Rhyddid* (2023).

CYFARWYDDWR | DIRECTOR

Steffan Donnelly yw Cyfarwyddwr Artistig a Chyd-Brif Weithredwr Theatr Genedlaethol Cymru. Ar ôl graddio o'r Guildhall School of Music and Drama yn Llundain, sefydlodd Gwmni Theatr Invertigo sydd wedi teithio ledled Cymru ac yn rhyngwladol gyda sawl cynhyrchiad megis *Saer Doliau, Y Tŵr, My Body Welsh, My People, Derwen, a Gŵyl Rithiol Pererindod*. Mae ei waith diweddar fel cyfarwyddwr yn cynnwys *Rhinoseros, Kiki Cymraeg a Gwlad yr Asyn* (Theatr Genedlaethol Cymru) a ffilmiau byrion *Monologau'r Maes* gyda Siân Phillips a John Ogwen (Eisteddfod Genedlaethol Cymru). Mae ei waith fel actor yn cynnwys gweithio yn y Barbican, Theatr Clwyd,

Steffan Donnelly is the Artistic Director and Joint Chief Executive of Theatr Genedlaethol Cymru.
