Mae'n gweithio fel cyflwynydd plant i raglen *Stwnsh Sadwrn* yn wythnosol ac wedi ymddangos ar raglenni *Chwarter Call*, *Pigo Dy Drwyn* a *Mabinogiogi*.

Originally from Ffair-Rhos and having graduated with a Performing BA and MA from University of Wales Trinity Saint David, Cadi has now settled in Cardiff. Since graduating she's worked with Arad Goch, Boom Plant, Mewn Cymeriad and is looking forward to working on Theatr Cymru's production of *Wes Wes!*. Cadi works as a children's presenter on the weekly programme, *Stwnsh Sadwrn* and has appeared on *Chwarter Call*, *Pigo dy drwyn* and *Mabinogiogi*.

She wrote and performed in *The Harri-Parris* comedy shows inspired by her farming family in West Wales. The comedy shows travelled across the country and to the Edinburgh Festival before becoming a popular radio sitcom on BBC Radio Wales.

Llinos has written for *Cara Fi*, *Cacamwnci*, *Anni Bendod*, *Dechrau Canu Dechrau Cwyno*, and *Noson Gomedi: Dathlu 40*, all for S4C. Her theatre work includes *Meiddio Meddwl* for Theatr Iolo/Eisteddfod Genedlaethol Cymru, the comedy musical *Anthem* for the Wales Millennium Centre and she translated *Tidy/Taclus* for Theatr Iolo.

Leo Drayton

Dramodydd / Playwright

Mae Leo Drayton (fe/fo) yn awdur cwiar o Gaerdydd sydd yn ysgrifennu yn bennaf am ei hunaniaeth a'i brofiad fel dyn traws. Leo Drayton (he/he) is a queer writer from Cardiff who mainly writes about his identity and experience as a trans man. He began his theatre work by collaborating with Elgan Rhys on *Dy Enw Marw* (2024), which was performed at the National Theatre in London by Ysgol Gyfun Gŵyr, creating history as the first Welsh drama to be staged there. Leo has written a number of short films including the award-winning comedy film *Teth* (2024) which reached the BFI Flare selection, the first Welsh language film to be shown at the festival as well as a number of film festivals around the world. Last year, he wrote his first stage play, *Dynolwaith*, with Frân Wen which opened at The Sherman Theatre before touring throughout Wales. The play was included in The Stage's list of the 50 best plays in the UK in 2025.



Geraint Lewis

Dramodydd / Playwright

Geraint Lewis comes from Tregaron, Ceredigion. He published five novels and three volumes of short stories, and his latest novel will be published in Spring 2027 by Gwasg Carreg Gwalch. He was the first winner of the Tony Bianchi Memorial Award in 2019, and his novel *Lloerig* came second for Y Fedal Rhyddiaith in 2021. Geraint wrote extensively for radio and television and his short comedy, *Byd Donna Tan y Pandy*, was performed by Theatr Cymru at the 2024 Rhondda Cynon Taf National Eisteddfod, Pontypridd in their *Ha/Ha!* production. His new play, *Islwyn*, about the writer Islwyn Ffowc Elis, will be touring Wales in September in a production by Mewn Cymeriad. He lives in Aberaeron with his wife Siân.

Dramodydd / Playwright
